## 4.2 Level Adjustment

Install this game on a flat surface.

If the game is installed on an unsuitable floor, it could cause levelers leave the floor. It could cause game malfunction.

To secure the game, loosen the nut, utilize wrench to adjust the leveler down until it touches the floor. Fix the nut back. Repeat the same for all levelers.

## 4.3 Height Adjustment

There are two ways to adjust the height.

1. Rocker switch adjustment

**Step 1** Locate the Service door (the side near display) and open it.



**Step 2** Locate the rocker switch indicated by circle.

Press UP to raise the height and press DOWN to lower the height.





## 2.Remote control adjustment

Press Up to raise the height and press DOWN to lower the height. Press STOP to stop.

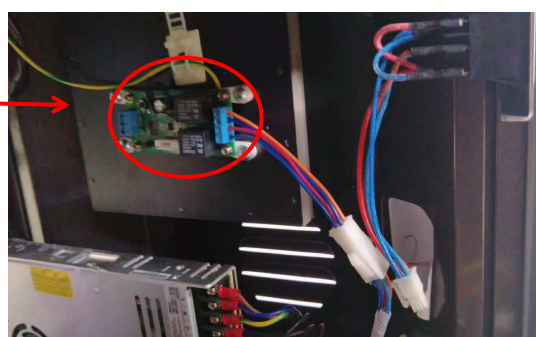
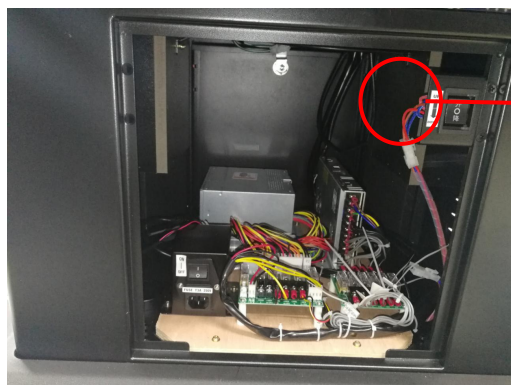

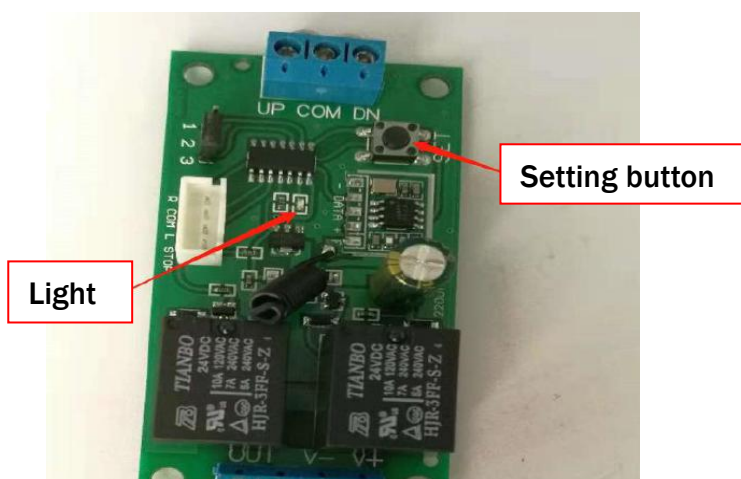
**Step 1** Locate the Service door(the side near display) and open it.



**Step 2** Locate the remote control indicated by circle.



**Step 3** Long press the setting button for 3-4s. If the light is on, clear code operation is finish.





**Step 4** Match code instruction:

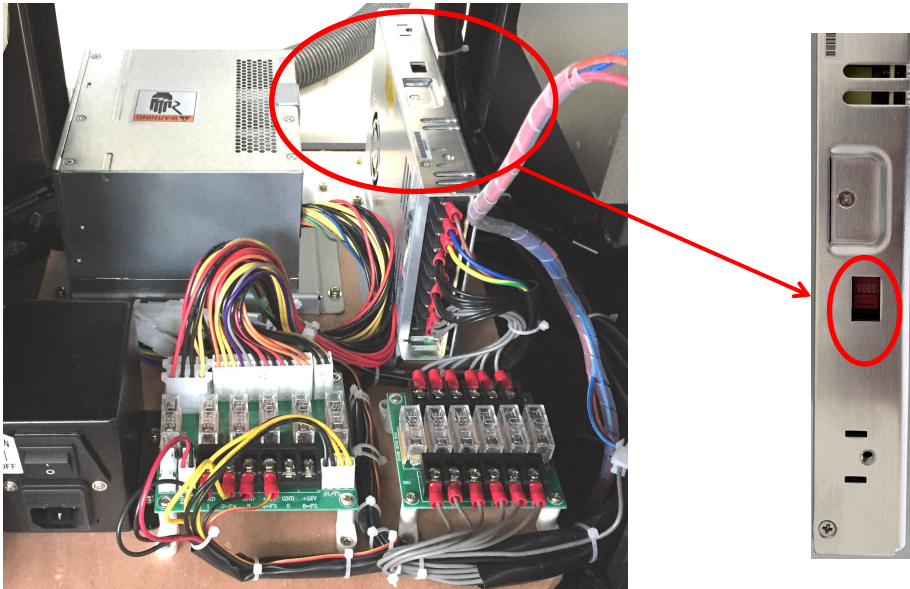
1. Press setting button, the light is on.
2. Press remote control UP, the light flashes first and then stay on.
3. Press remote control DOWN, the light flashes first and then stay on.
4. Press remote control STOP, the light flashes first and then stay on.
5. Press remote control STOP again, the light flashes first and then stop. The match code operation finish.

**4.4 Voltage Conversion**

Locate the Power supply. Loosen the power supply cover screws and take it off. Toggle the switches to 115V or 230V according to your need.



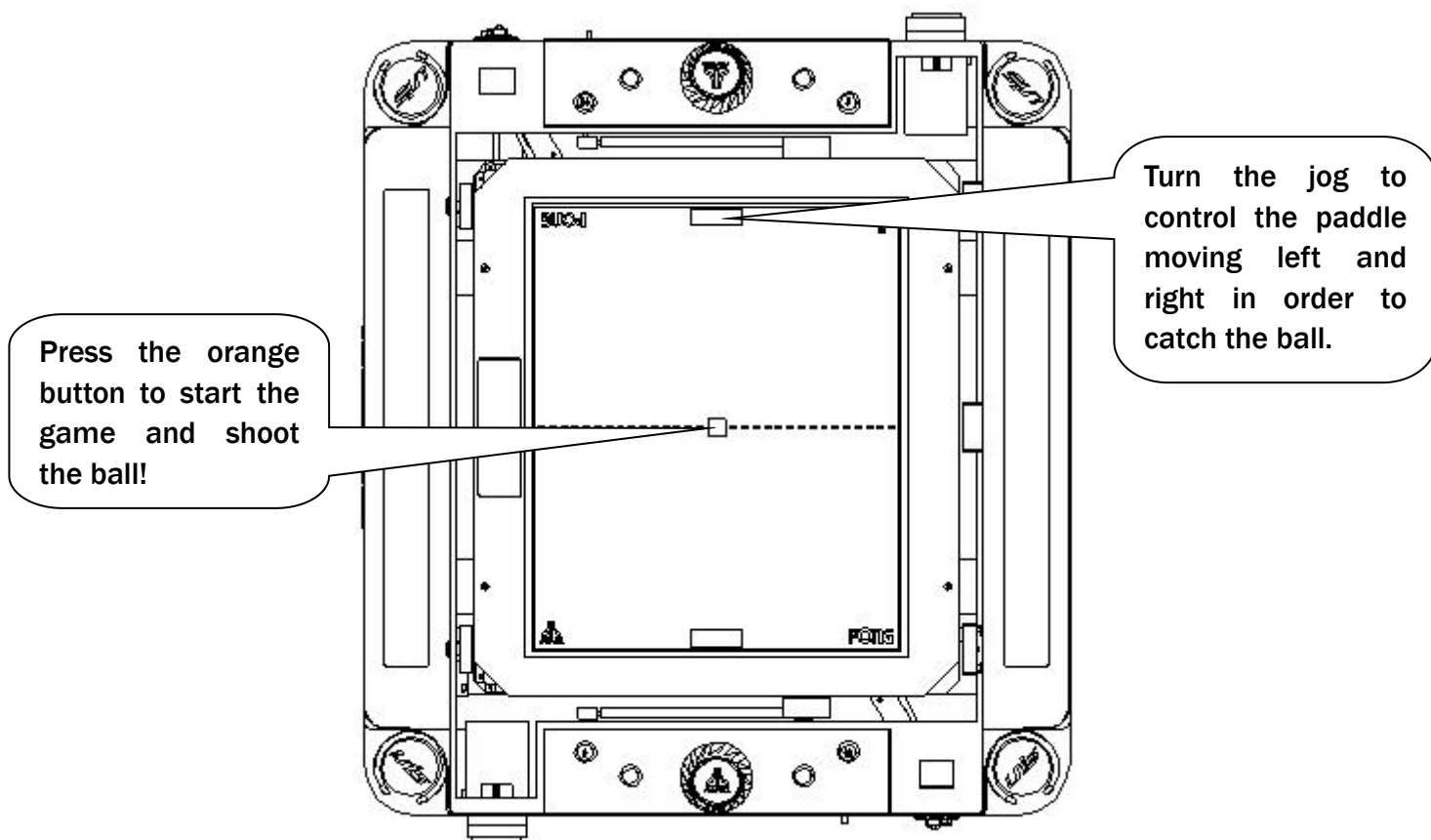
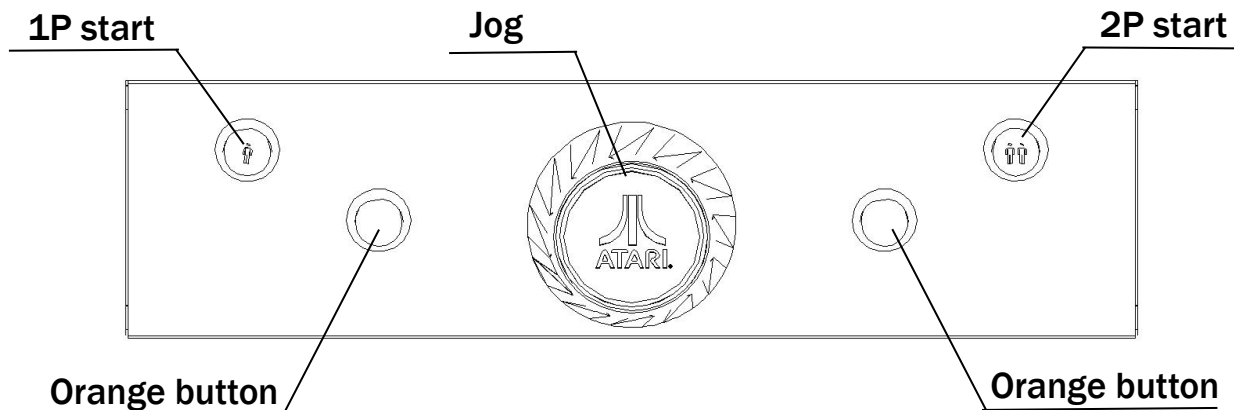
**4.5 Card Reader Installation Safety Notice**

## 5. HOW TO PLAY

5.1 Press 1P Start button or 2P Start button to start the game. Move the jog to control the paddle, press the orange button to shoot. (Same function as the two orange buttons)



## 6. GAME OPTION

Enter into the setting menu

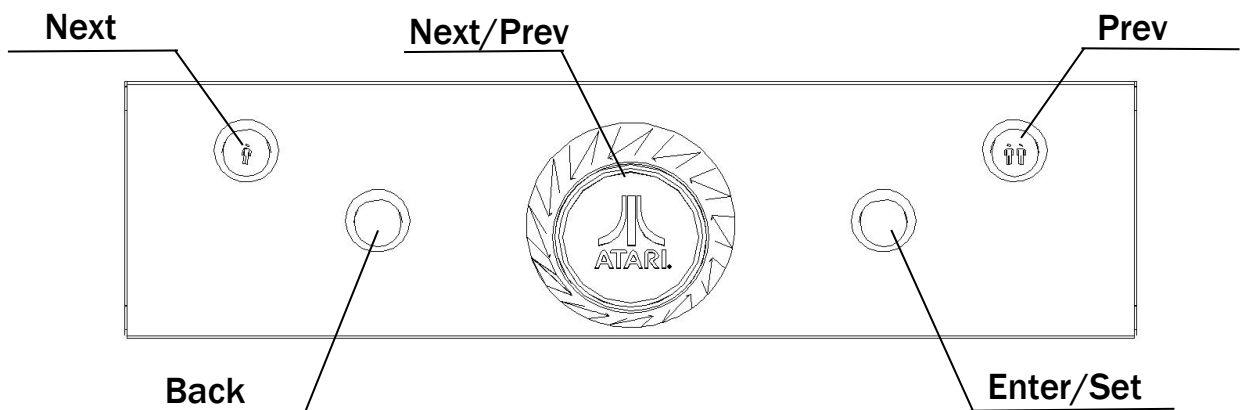
**Step 1** Locate the Coin door(the side near display) and open it.



**Step 2** Press Settings button to move the Ball to the middle and press Settings button again, then you'll see "CONF" on the display.(It doesn't work during game over.)

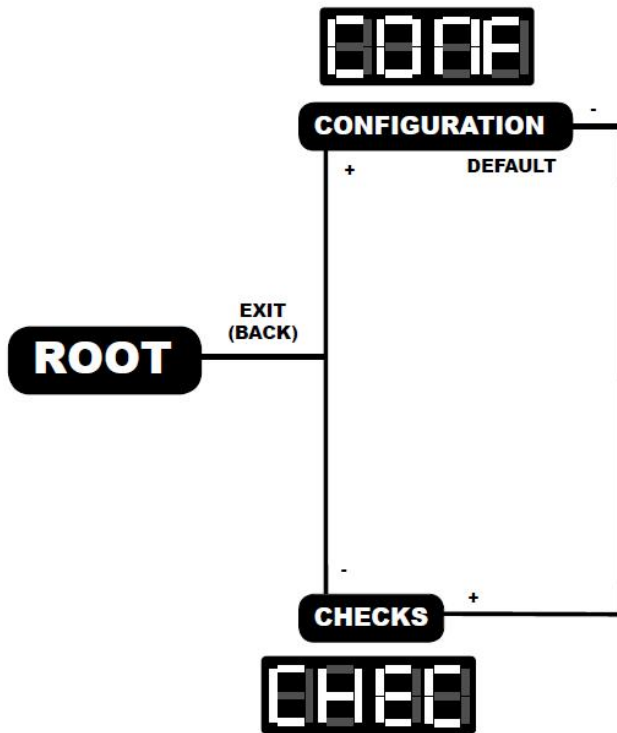


Roll the jog or press 1P and 2P to select the setting, press the right orange button to enter and set, press the left orange button to exit.



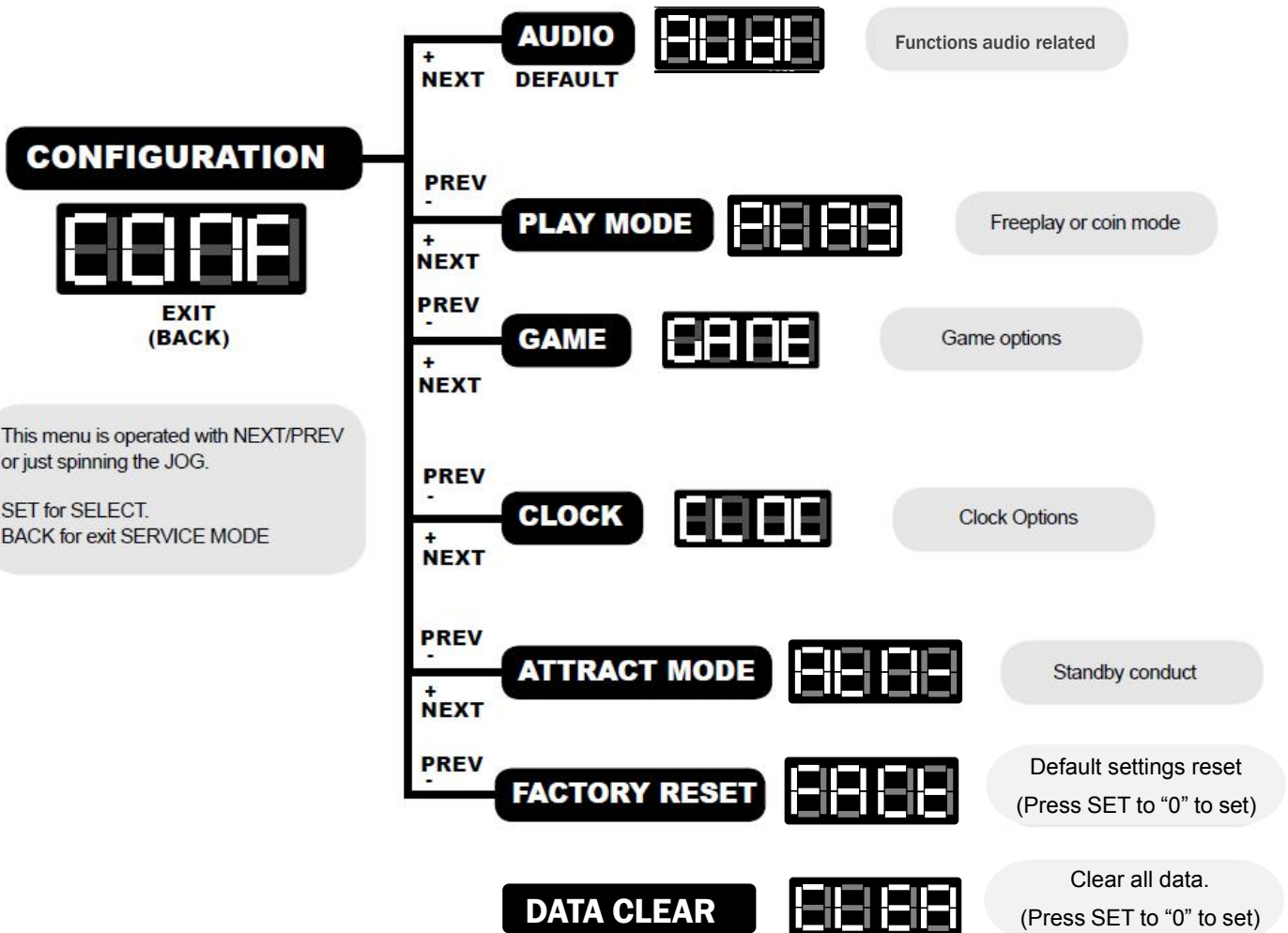

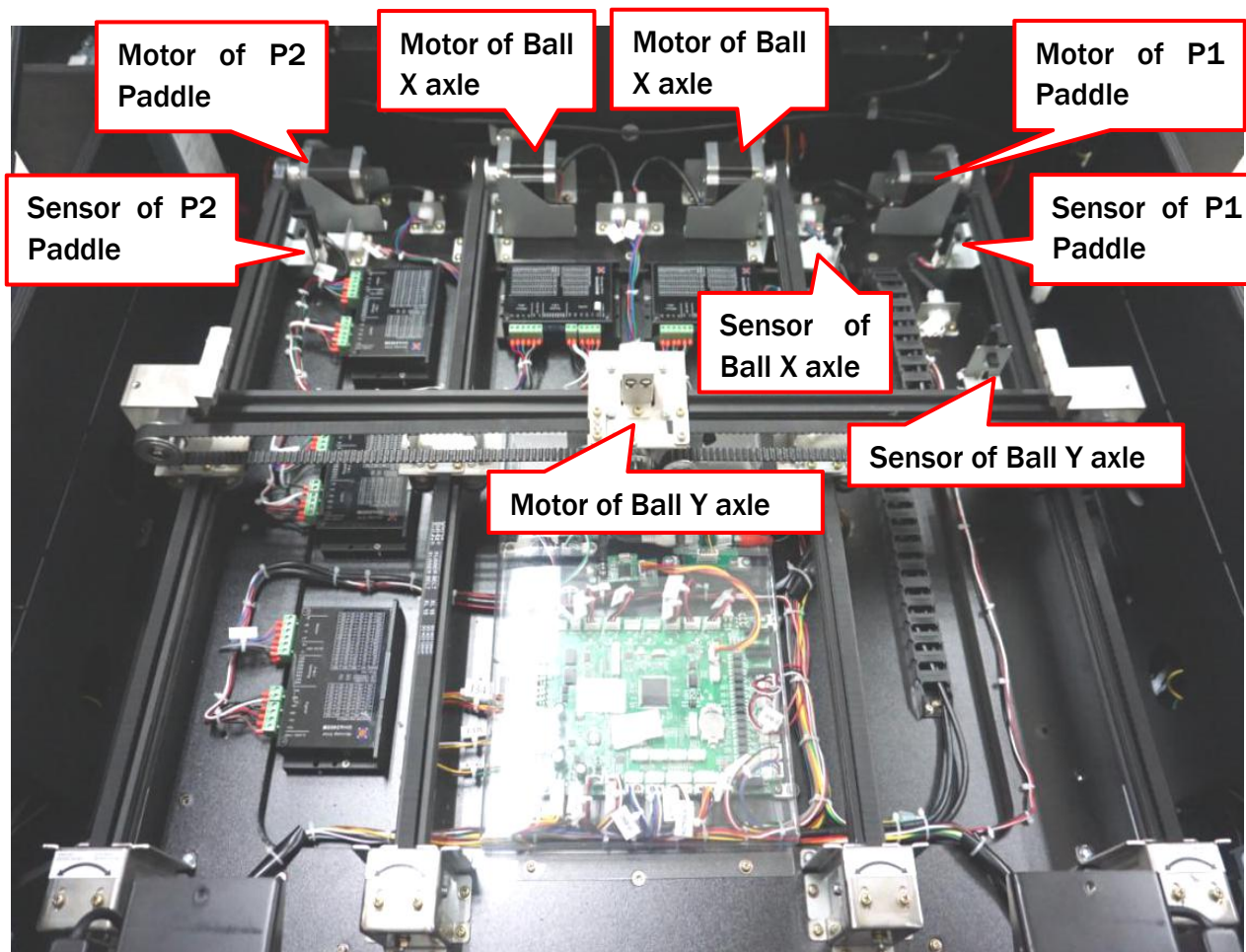
### 7.1 Common Problem

Please confirm that all connectors fit tightly.

Symptom	Possible Cause	Recommended action
Game will not start	Frame assembly connector is loose.	Check connector.
	Frame assembly is faulty.	Contact UNIS Service.
Power off	Circuit protector changes power SW to "off".	Turn on power SW again. If appeared again and again, machine has anomaly. Please contact UNIS Service.
No sound	Low volume	Raise the volume.
	Connector loose.	Check connector.
	Speaker is faulty.	Check speaker.
	Audio cable problem.	Reconnect the audio cable or change it.
	Driver problem	Restart the audio driver.
Ball shaking	The bottom of the Ball or the playfield has dirt.	Utilize non-woven fabric with distilled water to clean the bottom of the Ball.

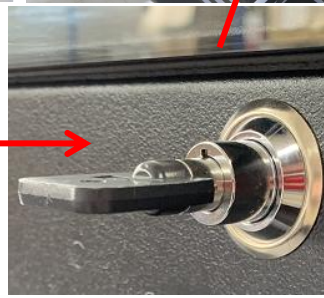
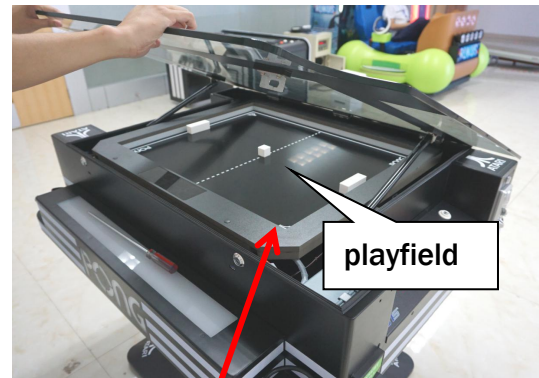

**Step 1** Locate the Service door(the side near display) and open it. Power off the game.



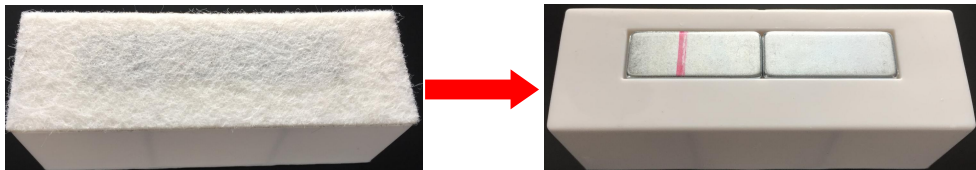

## 8.7 Belt Tension Adjustment Instruction for Y Axle

If noise is heard from the tracks inside the machine, one of the reasons is that the belt has loosened. Here is the process to tighten the belt.

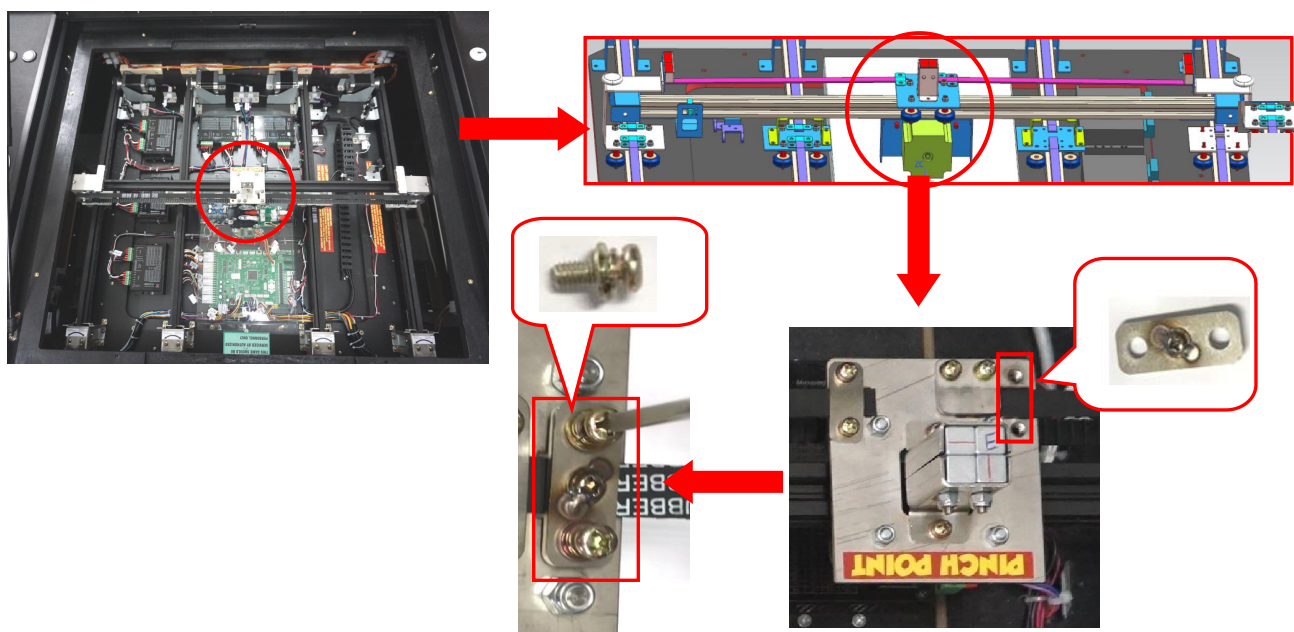

**Step 1** Follow the 8.6 steps to remove the playfield.

**Step 2** Locate ball movement mechanism and place adjust plate A on it. Utilize Phillip's screwdriver to tighten two screws to fix the adjust plate A to the ball movement mechanism.





**Step 3** If the belt is still loose, please remove adjust plate A and install adjust plate B to the ball movement mechanism. (The installation method is the same as Step 2.)

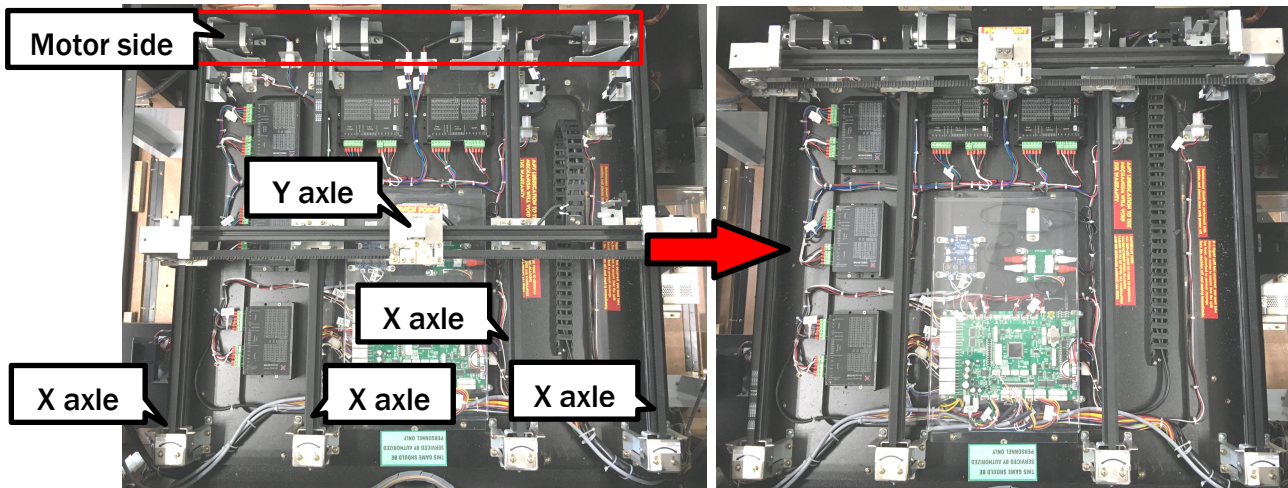

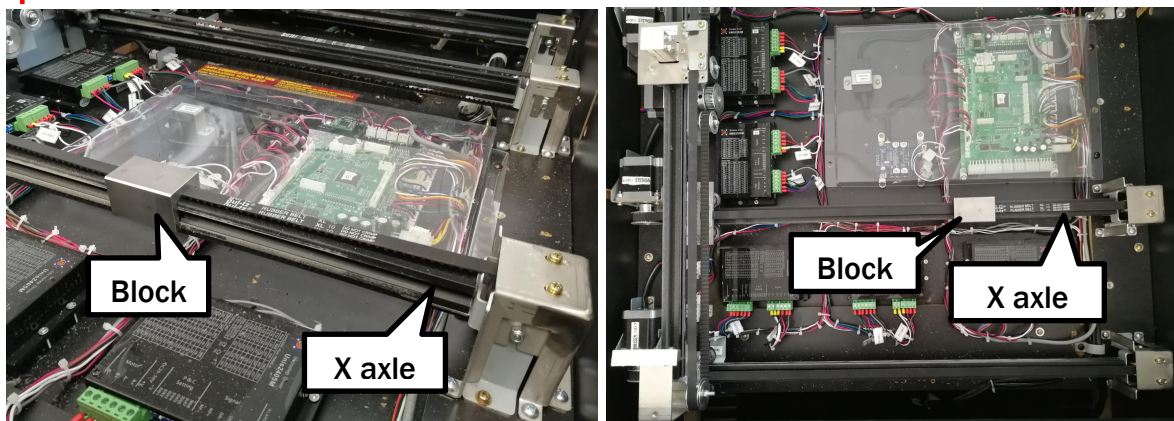

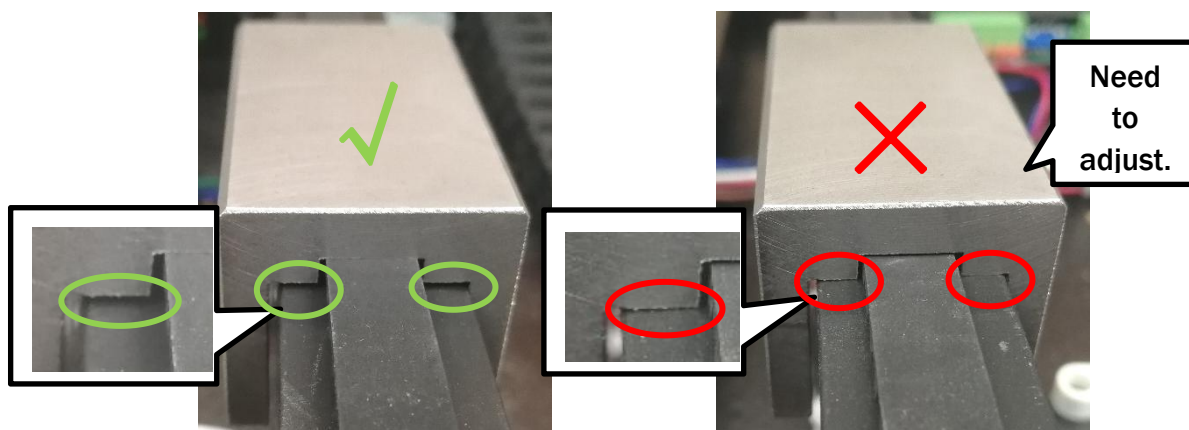
**Step 1** Follow the 8.6 steps to remove the playfield. Move Y axle to motor side.



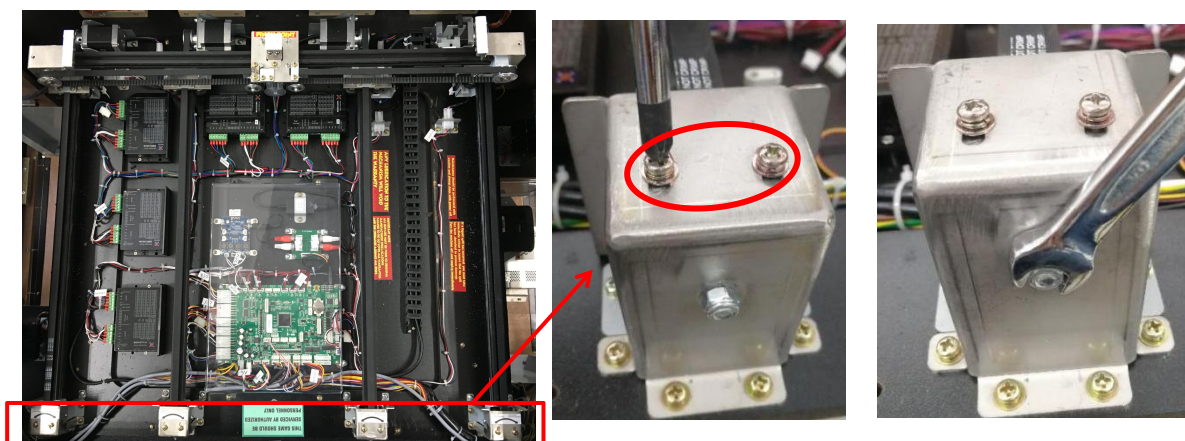
**Step 2** Locate one X axle. Place the block in the middle of the X axle.



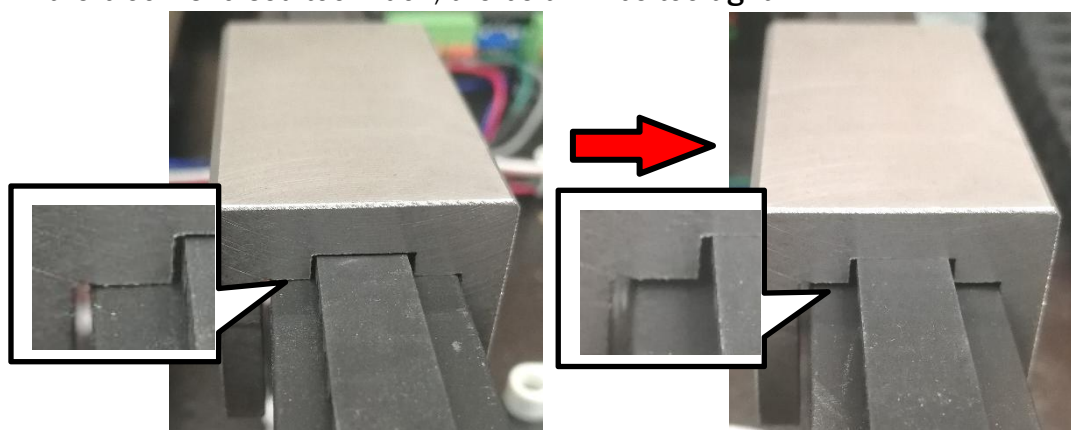
**Step 3** Check if the block is slightly above the X axle (within 0.04inch). If it is, don't adjust the belt; if it touches the X axle, adjust the belt.



**Step 4** To adjust: Utilize Phillips screwdriver to loosen the screws a bit. Utilize the wrench to adjust the nut on the side.



**Step 5** To adjust: Pay attention to the block when turning the wrench clockwise. Stop turning the wrench when the block is slightly raised (within 0.04 inch above the X axle). If the block is raised too much, the belt will be too tight.

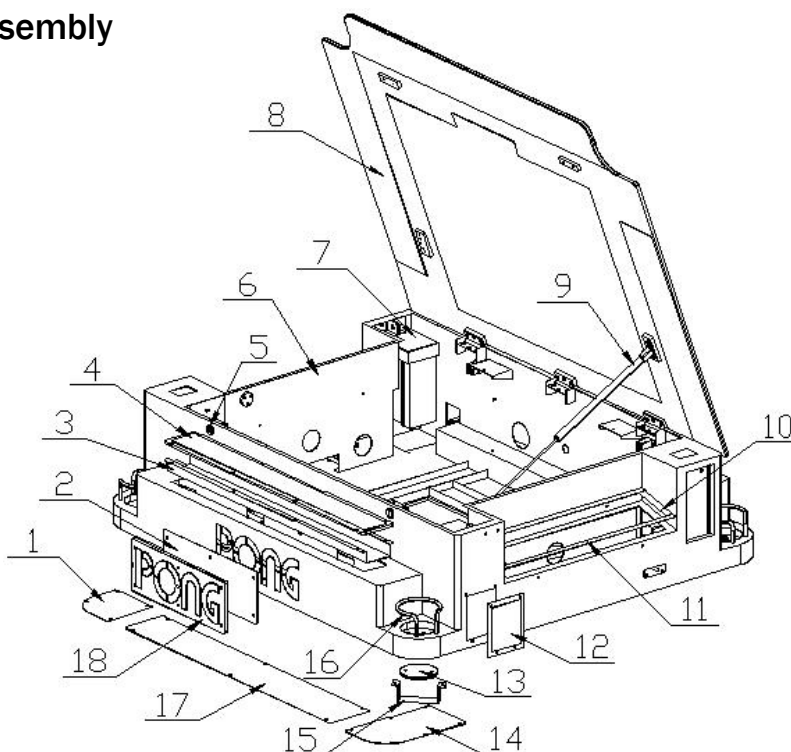


**Step 6** To adjust: Remove the block and tighten the screws in **Step 4**. The adjustment method for all the 4 X axles is the same.

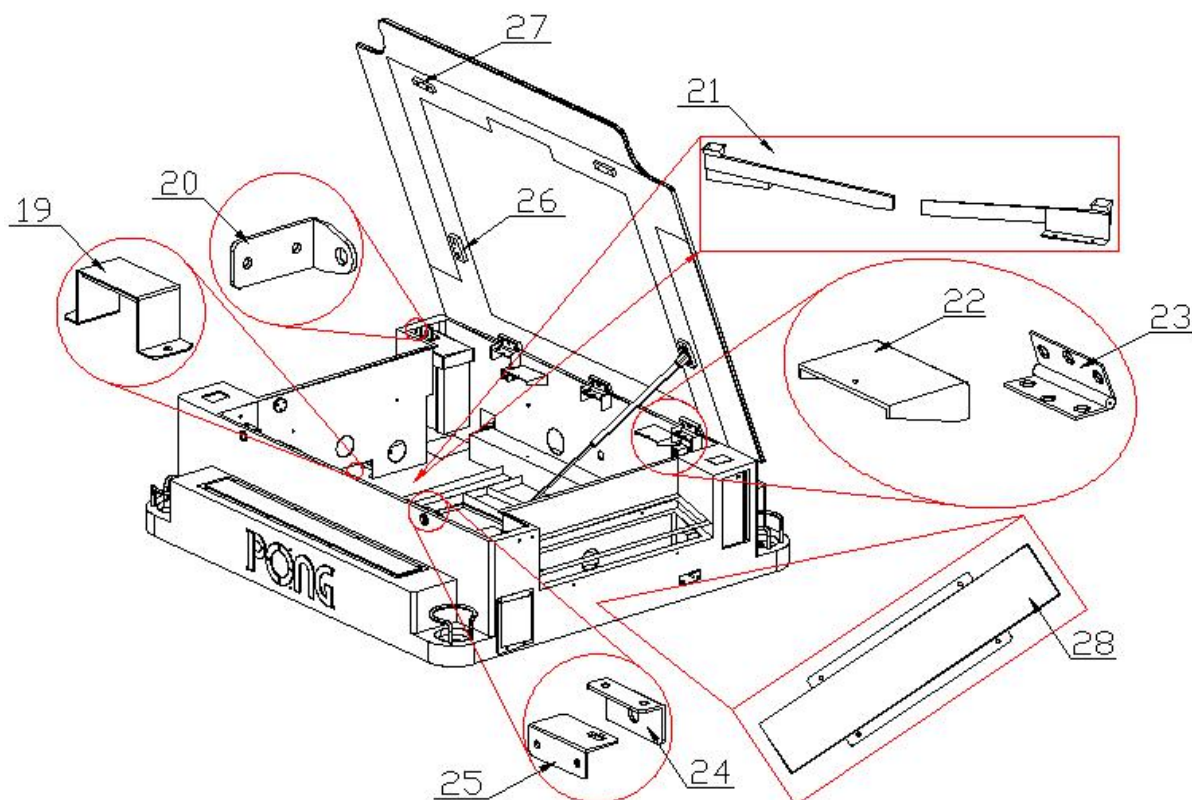

<b>Paddles</b>			
<b>1</b>	Check quarterly. If the bottom of the Paddle has dirt, utilize the non-woven fabric with distilled water to clean. If the bottom of the Paddle is damaged, replace the Wool felt pad on the Paddle. (Refer to 8.4)		
<b>2</b>	Replace the Wool felt pad on the Paddles once in every 1.5 years. (Refer to 8.4)		
<b>Playfield</b>			
<b>1</b>	Check quarterly. If the surface of the Playfield has dirt, utilize the non-woven fabric with distilled water to clean. (Refer to 8.3)		
<b>2</b>	Replace the Playfield once in every 2-3 years.		
<b>Belts</b>			
<b>1</b>	Check once in every 6 months if the Belts are loose. (Refer to 8.7 and 8.8)		
<b>2</b>	Replace the Belts once in every 2-3 years.		
<b>Wheels</b>			
<b>1</b>	Replace the Wheels once in every 1000 hours or 2 years.		

Any repairs of parts replacements must be executed with factory standards and only factory authorized parts are to be utilized.
